In an uncollected poem of 1995, 'MacNeice's London', Derek Mahon imagines Louis MacNeice in wartime, in 'A bunker of civilised sound, / A BBC studio'Â Only 10.2% of perch muscle analyses from Lake Lemman exceeded the WHO limits. The fish in Lakes Neuchatel and Joux had lower levels of pollution. Trout from Lake Lemman, like the predators (birds of prey, herons, grebes, mergansers) are more highly contaminated by mercury, only 1 trout in 6 having less than 0.5 ppm mercury in the liver.
