

Hypothesis

- Post cold war the world order shifted from bipolar to unipolar. Then the forces of Globalization took over the world order. However, they failed to make an impact to generate an homogeneous world order. Thereafter, the rise of Islamic fundamentalism challenged the supremacy of super powers eventually leading to a fractured world order.
- The strategic relations between India and USA have also undergone changes pre and post cold war period. Yesterday's antagonists have become strategic partners, having succumb to change in the strategic Mosaic of the world and the South Asian region.
- India US proximity is not an exclusive development as the forces of Globalization have brought the nations so close that a state cannot remain isolated from the events happening in the nearby region or the world at large, simultaneously making a significant change to their own insecurity dilemmas.

India-Russia relationship has evolved into an equal partnership. The deep roots of this relationship go back to the early 20th century when India was under British rule and the Czars ruled Russia. The Russian Revolution of 1905 inspired Indian freedom fighters. Mahatma Gandhi was also struck by the similarity in the prevailing conditions in Russia and India. He developed a close connection with Russia and carried on lengthy correspondence with Leo Tolstoy. Russia's communist leader V.I. Lenin followed with interest and sympathy the nascent Indian freedom struggle. Northern states like Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Haryana and Rajasthan which are known to be deeply patriarchal, have much lower divorce and separation rates. Also given that rates of living together before marriage are extremely low in India and marriage is universal, it wouldn't be surprising that for some members of the younger people, first marriages can end up in divorce." Nupur Dhingra Paiva, a Delhi-based clinical child psychologist, tells me that when she started out three years ago, she would barely get one case every two months of divorced parents bringing in their troubled children for counselling. "Now I get one such case every week. The couples are all middle and upper-middle class, and both the man and woman are working. India has the world's sixth largest economy, and is self sufficient in foods. India also has a large industrial sector and large coal reserves. India and the US are currently in the midst of a two decade long strategic convergence. The US and Indian peoples each have more than 55% of their population viewing each other positively, bilateral trade is approaching the 150 billion USD mark, millions of Indians call America home, and the current leadership of President Trump and PM Modi understand each other very well, making for effective diplomacy and geopolitical deal making.
